

Qualitative Data Collection and Analysis

In this course, participants will learn skills to develop qualitative research questions and data collection strategies. The workshop promotes understanding and use of computer programs in qualitative analysis. Participants gain hands-on experience as they learn different ways to code or systematically mark text for ideas, themes, and topics of interest. Participants will learn a variety of coding options to organize and evaluate the material in transcripts and texts, and techniques to organize specific material for the participant's own project. Instructors will demonstrate how to select the best coding strategies and how to generate reports that list and link the coded text where related terms, phrases, and paragraphs of specific information are located. Participants are encouraged to bring their own transcripts or texts to work with.
